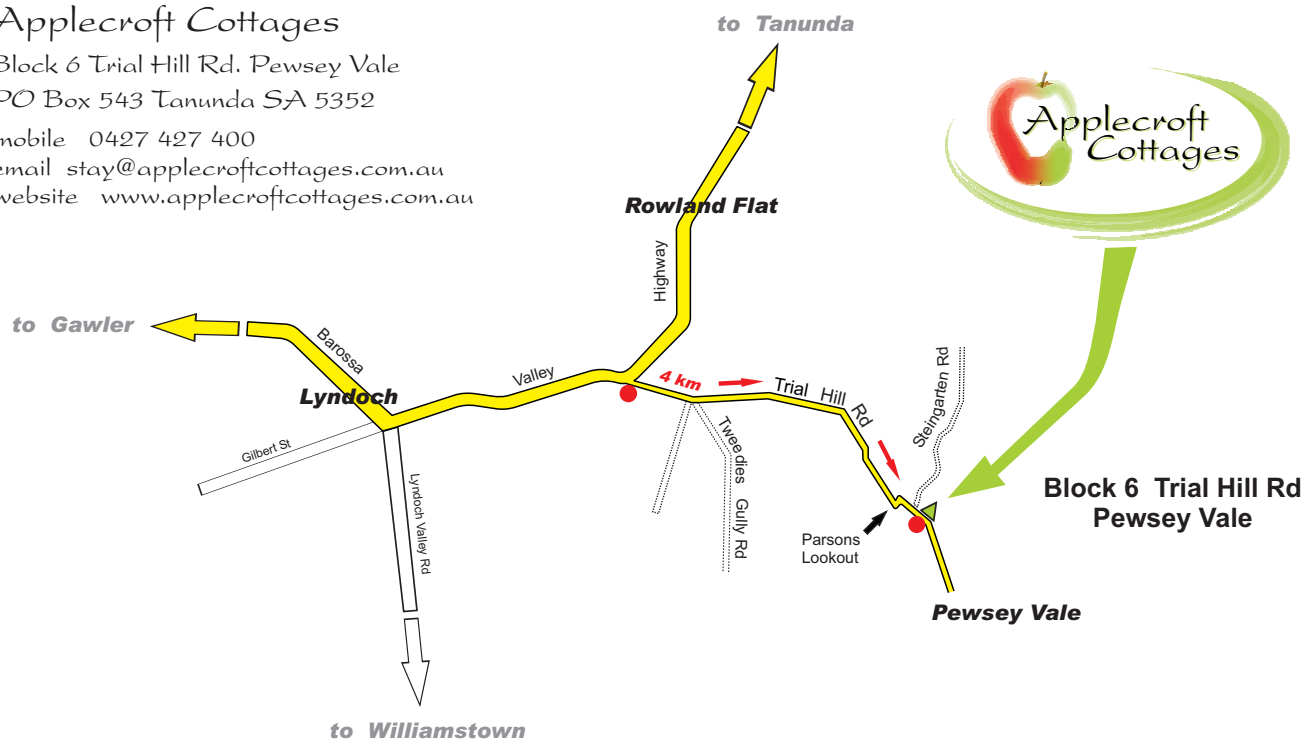

DIRECTIONS TO 'THE STUDIO' - APPLECROFT COTTAGES

- From Adelaide:** Take the Main North Road to Gawler.
When approaching Gawler, enter the township by taking the left exit off the Main North Road, just after the big green roadside sign.
(Don't be fooled by another big green sign which encourages you to head along the Gawler bypass. This will take you well out of your way, to the northern end of the Barossa Valley)
- From Gawler:** Travel through Gawler to the end of the shopping area.
At the traffic lights, turn right onto the Barossa Valley Highway. There is a signpost to Lyndoch (14 kilometres).
- At Lyndoch:** Staying on the Barossa Valley Highway, turn left, heading towards Rowland Flat and Tanunda.
About 2 ½ kilometres out of town, the road goes over a railway bridge and then takes a sharp left turn.
Instead of taking the turn to the left, turn right off the highway onto Trial Hill Road.
There is a stone wall here (it's floodlit at night) with a 'Jacob's Creek Visitor Centre' sign.
On the street post, there are a number of fingerposts, one of which is 'Applecroft Cottages'
- Trial Hill Road:** Glance at your odometer when you get onto Trial Hill Road, the B&B is approximately 4 kilometres away.
You'll travel gradually up a hill.
The bitumen road will turn into gravel approaching the Tweedies Gully Road turnoff.
At this turnoff, veer to the left, staying on Trial Hill Road. (There is another 'Applecroft Cottages' sign post here.)
Follow the road through several up's and down's and left's and right's and on through a gully.
The road then turns back into bitumen and climbs steeply up past Parson's Lookout.
The B&B is just over the top of the hill on the left, just after the Steingarten Rd turn off.
- At Applecroft:** The Studio driveway is adjacent to the sign, on the left.
Park under the carport, then follow the path through the garden and around to the front of the building.
The Studio has a small deck and floor to ceiling glass windows across the front.
